

It was painful to many but it was necessary to continue and increase our community programs.

I also invite people to please come and eat at the stated meeting dinners. The attendance has been low and due to the cost of the food we have been struggling to break even. The stated meeting dinners are expensive and we need to support the lodge by attending if you can. The less people that eat the more potential for loss of money to the lodge which will impact community events. Brother Barden and Wor. Folsom are running the dinners now and I assure you the food will be good and a great value at the non-changed \$10.00 per person, This did not increase.

Coming up in the next few months we will be hosting a training class for our AEDs that have been installed. This is an incredibly important training class and I invite everyone to attend. In the case of such emergency this could make the difference that could save a life. This training will be on one of the Brotherhood nights.

The 100 year anniversary tickets are quickly selling so please visit the website to purchase or pay Wor. Gowder or Wor. Brandes directly for your tickets. This is OUR time to shine and come out and celebrate this incredible milestone.



