Brethren, family and friends,

The month of February was a quiet one. We purposely kept things low key to allow your leadership team to complete the transition from last year's team and to ensure we have everything in place to make your experience as positive as we can.

Both the February dinner and stated meeting were well attended and I appreciate very much the support you all showed by being there! As I mentioned to you last month we are, over time, making some small changes to how the dinner is run including adding tablecloths and centerpieces to the tables and presenting a slideshow (Thanks Bro. Bill Greganti!) during dinner. As many of you may have noticed we held a small giveaway to celebrate Valentine's day (this was all Margaret Windle's idea :-). If any of you have any ideas or suggestions on how to further improve things please let me or any of your leadership team know we appreciate your input!

For March, our stated meeting will be held on March 7th. Dinner will be Margaret's corned beef and cabbage, red potatoes, carrots, cornbread and chocolate pistachio cake for dessert. As always a \$10 donation is much appreciated. We have a 1st degree practice scheduled for Wednesday the 13th and a First Degree TENTATIVELY scheduled for Thursday March 14th. On Saturday, March 16th at 1:00 PM at the lodge is our St. Patty's day BBQ hosted by our Communications and Events Committee presented by committee members Brothers Justin D'Silva and Joseph Rosas. Let us know if you are planning to attend; there will be food and games, so please come and join in on the fun!

In an effort to improve communications within the lodge, streamline operations and enhance the masonic experience for all of us, I wanted to go over a few small changes we are making to our policies and procedures that we are implementing effective immediately.

First, degree proficiencies will only be conducted at the end of each stated meeting. This is to make sure as many brothers as possible are there to support the candidate and to give your leadership team time to schedule and practice for the degree. This will ensure the best experience possible for both the candidate and the brethren in attendance.

Second, we want to reemphasize every brother's right to be heard during the stated meeting. To ensure we all have the opportunity to express ourselves in open lodge, we ask that if you have a motion to bring to the floor at the Stated Meeting you bring your motion to the officers' meeting immediately preceding it. So for example in March, the Stated Meeting is on the 7th so any motion to be brought to the floor on the 7th must be brought to the officer's meeting on the 6th. This is to ensure your officers have the chance to discuss your motion ahead of time allowing your voice to be heard in lodge by the membership in a smooth and orderly fashion. Additionally, if your motion involves expenditure of lodge funds, it gives us time to evaluate the motion and ensure funds are both available and within the scope of our budget prior to a vote.

Third, while making new Masons is the lifeblood of any lodge, we must remember that we are charged to only bring men through our doors who we have strong reason to believe will reflect honor on our beloved fraternity. To be obedient to this charge, we are asking that all applications be brought to the officers' meeting prior to the Stated Meeting. This is to again allow sufficient time for our leadership team to review an application prior to being read in lodge and to ensure a candidate has the best chance at membership possible before they are brought to you.

Lastly I am challenging any and all of us who make the decision to act as a "top line signer" of a candidate that we commit to serving as their degree coach throughout their journey through the degrees. This, in my view is how we all learn the ritual in the time honored way by passing it from mouth to ear and also how the ritual binds us together both on fraternal and personal levels.

My Brothers, the goal of any change we make is to improve and enhance the masonic experience for all of us. I hope as we move forward this year that if you have any ideas on how we can improve you will let us know. Remember, the officers of the lodge are in place to serve you and the best way for us to serve you is by hearing from those who we serve.
