Brethren, family and friends,

March has been a busy month so far around Yorba Linda Lodge. Our Stated meeting and St. Patty's day BBQ were both well attended and I think by all accounts everyone had a great time! The food at both events was great and I would like to give a special shout out to Brothers Joseph Rosas and Justin DaSilva and our own Margaret Windle for all of your efforts. The lodge appreciates your help!

April will start with our Stated Meeting on April 4th. During the Stated Meeting we will be awarding a 50 year pin to Brother Glenn Carey. Please come out and support Brother Carey on his special day. Finally, Brother Sam Tapia will be returning his Entered Apprentice proficiency at the April Stated Meeting.

April is Public Schools Month for all lodges in California. California Masons began supporting Public Schools in 1920 when Charles Adams, a San Francisco attorney and Grand Master who was passionate about California schools, proclaimed Public Schools Week. During that week, Masonic lodges led community meetings to respond to the state's critical teacher shortage. Each succeeding Grand Master in California has continued the observance of Public Schools Week, now Public Schools Month.

In keeping with this long standing tradition, we will be holding our annual Public Schools Night on Thursday April 25th. Brother Keven Kennedy is the leader of this event and he is looking for brothers to help him both in planning and working the event. If you're interested in helping out please attend the April Stated Meeting and see either myself or Brother Kennedy and we will get you started.

Lastly I would like to share a part of an article written by Brother Jim Barden who is our Jr. Deacon and the Chief Financial Officer of the Yorba Linda Masonic Hall Association. In his article, Brother Barden summarizes what has been accomplished over the past five years and looks forward to 2019 and beyond.



In 2014 we repainted the exterior of the building, slurry sealed and restriped the parking lot, installed exterior signage and lighting and remodeled the banquet room, restroom and kitchen.

In 2015 we installed a new sound system and ceiling tiles in the banquet room, as well as purchased 100 new chairs replacing our aging old folding chairs.

In 2016 we opened a walkway between the city owned parking lot to our west and our parking lot on the north side of the building.

In 2017 we completely refurbished the upstairs of our facility. We took most of the upstairs down to the studs, insulated the walls, reconfigured the electrical and HVAC systems, removed the old kitchen and stationary folding theatre chairs in the lodge and essentially created all new spaces. The result is amazing and each of us should be very proud.

In 2018, with our 100-year celebration upon us we put the finishing touches on our improvements, replaced all three of our HVAC units and one additional HVAC unit in our rental space.

Looking to 2019 and beyond, our parking lot is again in need of resealing and repair, we have several areas of uneven concrete and a walkway on the south and west sides of the building that need addressing. Our roof is nearing the end of its useful life and our elevator will need to be replaced/upgraded by 2023 at a cost of some \$60,000. We'd also like to consider replacing our windows at some time in the not-so-distant future.

With all of this completed and more to be done, we're also becoming acutely aware of the importance and necessity of having a thorough "Reserve Study" completed to guide us in our annual planning and to assure that we have adequate funds in reserve to cover the ongoing costs of maintaining our beloved facility for the next 100 years.

As you can see much has been done but as with all property ownership there is always more to be done. So, our Hall Association President, Bro. JR Nichols will be asking for our help in the form of work parties over the coming year and I hope, when called upon, as many of us who can will step up to help. I, for one, believe they deserve our thanks, our support, and most importantly our time, given all the Hall Association has done for us and our beloved building,.
