I would like to start out with a very sad bit of news. Our own Worshipful Brother Glenn, E. Martin and Brother Peter Whited passed away during April. Worshipful Glenn passed away on April 22nd, 2019. Glenn was Initiated on December 10th 1976, passed to the degree of Fellowcraft on April 15th 1977 and raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason on July 8th 1977. Glenn served as Master of Yorba Linda lodge in 1999, received the Grand Masters Youth Service Award in 2013 and the Hiram Award in 2016. He was my friend and Brother and will be sorely missed. Brother Peter passed away on April 27th 2019. Peter was initiated an Entered Apprentice Mason on June 14th 1962, Passed to the degree of Fellowcraft on July 12th 1962 and raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason on August 9th 1962.
